Job description

The Cybersecurity and Telecommunications Research Lab (CTRL) is interested in hiring three (3) scientists with computer science, or other relevant background, to join our team and work in specific national and/or European funded and other R&D projects related to cybersecurity.

Employment terms

Positions will be filled through fixed-term, part-time or full-time employment contracts, and can be renewed depending on performance and the projects' needs. The monthly time commitment of hired applicants is up to 140 hours per month, depending on the full, or part time contract offered to the applicants. Insurance is provided through the national health system. A 13th month's salary is not provided.

The gross monthly salary for the advertised positions will be between €500 - €2.200 and will depend on the hired applicants' qualifications and experience and contract type. Employer contributions are provided by the Open University of Cyprus.

Role

The scientists, depending on their background and their employment contract type, will work with the CTRL team on the following activities: Design and development of cybersecurity curricula and educational material, usage of Cyber Ranges and educational technologies, prepare research proposals, contribute to project deliverables and research projects.

- Preference for a BSc, MSc, or PhD degree in Computer Science, or related Engineering field, or other related fields
- Understanding of cybersecurity and networking principles
- Experience in designing and developing cybersecurity related educational material
- Experience in research projects
- Written and oral communication skills in English language
