The Cybersecurity and Telecommunications Research Lab (CTRL) is interested in hiring a highly skilled Research Scientist with proven expertise to join our team.

Employment terms

Position will be filled through fixed-term employment contracts and can be renewed depending on performance and projects' needs. The monthly time commitment of hired applicant is up to 140 hours, depending on the full or part time status of the relevant project/contract. Insurance is provided through the national health system. A 13th month salary is not provided.

The gross monthly salary for the Research Scientist position will be between €5.000 – €7.000 for full time employment (pro rata for part-time employment), including employer contributions, and will depend on the hired applicant's qualifications and past experience.

Role

The Researcher will work with OUC's CTRL team to enhance and support existing research tools and platforms, develop, and implement new platforms in various environments, automate processes, write technical documentation, contribute to, and manage research projects.

Requirements and qualifications

- Preference for a BSc degree in areas related to CTRL activities
- MSc degree in Computer and Network security or security related areas
- Experience in Cyber Range Development, including ICT and aeronautical technologies and science.
- Experience of Python and Django web framework
- Experience of API Integrations
- Experience in designing and implementing networked ICT platforms from concept to implementation
- Written and oral communication skills in English language
